FIRST APPEARANCE REQUIRED
UPON RETURN OF INDIVIDUAL
AFTER OUT-OF-COUNTY ARREST

THIS MATTER came before the undersigned as Administrative Judge of Citrus County, and this Court having deemed it necessary to clarify the procedures for first appearance upon return to the Citrus County Jail of a person who was arrested or detained in another county or jurisdiction, and this Court having determined that the rights of the arrested individual and the interests of judicial efficiency will be served best by the procedures set forth below, it is thereupon

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. Upon the arrival to the Citrus County Jail of any person who is arrested and detained in another county in the state of Florida, or any other jurisdiction, said person shall be brought before the first appearance judge within 24 hours of arriving at the Citrus County Jail. It shall be the responsibility of the Citrus County Jail to ensure that such persons are timely brought before the court for first appearance within said 24 hour time period.
