JUDGE ROGERS' PROCEDURES FOR CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCES

- 1. The court reserves one full day each month for the sole purpose of conducting case management conferences.
- 2. The parties may request a case management conference as provided by <u>Florida Rule of Civil Procedure</u> 1.200(a) (2013).
- 3. The court may also set a case management conference, *sua sponte*.
- 4. Upon the filing of a Motion for Case Management Conference, it is not necessary to contact the court for a hearing. The court will set a hearing on the next available day reserved for case management conferences, and will provide notice to the parties. If you do not receive a notice of case management conference within two (2) weeks of filing a Motion for Case Management Conference, please contact the court at rogers.hearings@circuit5.org to inquire about your motion.
- 5. At the case management conference, the court may consider any/all the items contained in the 1.200(a). However, the primary issue of concern to the court will be determining when the case will be set for trial.
- 6. Parties may attend the case management conference in person, or by telephone via CourtCall.¹
