Judge Daniel B. Merritt, Sr. accepted a plea today in The State of Florida v. Sherrie Ann Dicus. The plea agreement was entered as follows:

- Count 1. Guilty, murder in the second degree in the death of Enrique Daniel Acevedo.
- Count 2. Guilty, attempted felony murder for the attempted murder of Skyler Nicolle Collins.
- Count 3. Guilty, carjacking while armed.
- Count 4. Guilty, robbery with a deadly weapon.

Dicus was charged along with codefendants Steven Allen Wesolek and Sabrina Marie Dicus for these crimes. Wesolek was sentenced on May 16, 2012 to life without the possibility of parole. Sabrina Marie Dicus entered a plea of guilty on September 22, 2011. Sabrina Dicus sentencing hearing was not to be held until after the trial of the two codefendants, her hearing has not been set at this time.

Judge Merritt will hold the sentencing hearing for Sherrie Ann Dicus in Courtroom E of the Hernando County Courthouse on Monday, October 22, 2012 at 8:30 AM.
