## <u>ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING THE IMPOSITION</u> OF CERTAIN COURT COSTS, FEES AND SURCHARGES

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit, by and through the Administrative Judge in and for Marion County, is responsible for the efficient and proper administration of justice and to ensure that statutorily mandated costs, fees, assessments, and surcharges are properly assessed and collected; and

**WHEREAS**, the Court recognizes that the Clerk of the Court assists the Court with preparation of dispositional orders and judgments, under the direction and supervision of the trial court; and

**WHEREAS,** the Court recognizes that the Clerk of the Court may require assistance and direction to provide uniformity when assessing said costs, fees, assessments, and surcharges.

In accordance with Article V, section 2, Florida Constitution, Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, Florida Statutes, Florida Statues, section 43.26 (2017) and *McNeil v. State*, 215 So.3d 55 (Fla. 2017), it is therefore

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that <u>effective October 1, 2017</u>, where applicable, the following costs, fees, assessments, and surcharges each shall be assessed and imposed *for each eligible count:* 

<b>§938.01</b>	\$3.00 (Additional Court Cost Clearing Trust Fund)
<b>§938.04</b>	5% (Court cost surcharge on criminal fines)
<b>§938.06</b>	\$20.00 (Crime Stoppers Trust Fund)
<b>§938.07</b>	\$135.00 (Driving or boating under the influence)
<b>§938.08</b>	\$201.00 (for enumerated offenses to fund Domestic Violence Trust Fund)
<b>§938.085</b>	\$151.00 (for enumerated offenses to fund Rape Crisis Trust Fund)
<b>§938.10</b>	\$151.00 (for enumerated offenses against minors)
§938.15	\$2.00 (Criminal justice education and training for local government)
§938.19	\$3.00 (Teen Court fee adopted by county ordinance)
§939.185	\$65.00 (additional court cost adopted by county ordinance)
