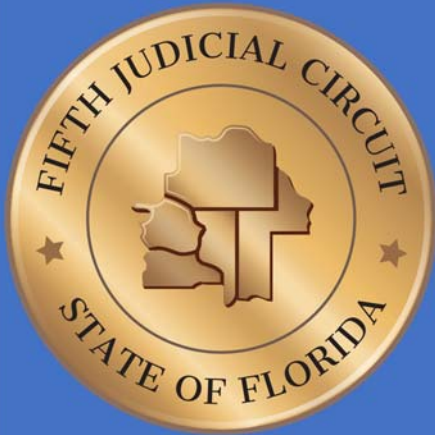

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT AS EXPERT WITNESS:

Qualifications:

All experts who are appointed to provide services with the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida must be a licensed physician, psychiatrist, registered nurse, nurse practitioner, licensed social worker in good standing with the State of Florida Department of Health, psychologist, gerontologist, or a person with experience and training with gerontology.

Adult Competency or Juvenile Competency evaluators must have satisfactorily completed the required forensic training approved by the Department of Children and Family Services.

Developmental Disability or Determination of Intellectual Disabilities as a Bar to Execution valuator must be found qualified by the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD). Information on becoming qualified may be found at APD's website, <http://apd.myflorida.com>, or by contacting the Central Region Field Office (Field 13) in Wildwood.

Registration:

Those who meet the above qualifications and wish to be appointed as an expert Witness in the Fifth Judicial Circuit must submit an application to be added to the Fifth Judicial Circuit Expert Witness Registry; and

Once approved for addition to the Fifth Judicial Circuit Expert Witness Registry, each expert selected must enter into a contract with the Fifth Judicial Circuit. Contracts will be for three (3) years. Each contract will begin on July 1, 2019 and end June 30, 2022.

Compensation:

Compensation, for expert services, is paid by the State of Florida at the rates set by the Court. The rates may be found in Administrative Order No. A-2017-23

Locations:

Expert Witnesses shall be required to provide services across the circuit, locations include: the Citrus County Courthouse, Inverness; Citrus County Jail, Lecanto; Hernando County Governmental Center, Brooksville; Hernando County Jail, Spring Hill; Hernando Correctional Institution, Brooksville; Springbrook Hospital, Brooksville; Lake County Courthouse, Tavares; Lifestreams Behavioral Center, Leesburg; Lake Correctional Institution, Clermont, Marion County Judicial Center, Ocala; Marion County Jail, Ocala; The Centers, Ocala; Sumter County Courthouse, Bushnell; Sumter County Jail, Bushnell, Sumter Correctional Institution, Bushnell, and such other facilities as required by the Court.

Rules:

All expert services must be provided in accordance with the Florida Rules of Court; the Code of Judicial Conduct; the Rules of Criminal Procedure; Sections 916.115, 916.301 – 916.304, 921.137, 393.11 and 985.19 Florida Statutes, Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.203, Rule of Juvenile Procedure 8.095, & Determination of Intellectual Disability as a Bar to Execution (Fla. R. Crim. P. 3.203).Fifth Judicial Circuit Administrative Order Nos. A-2017-23; and any other subsequent or applicable rule, law, or Administrative Order.
