ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING TRANSPORTATION OF INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS

THIS COURT having considered the need to formalize the processing of transport orders in the Circuit and County Courts of Hernando County, and having considered the orderly administration of justice and the efficient use of the resources of the Court, attorneys, the Clerk, the Sheriff and the jail, it is thereupon

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Upon the effective date of this Order, the procedure set forth herein shall be used in all cases, whether civil or criminal, for transportation of prisoners to the Hernando County Courthouse.
- 2. Attached hereto is the combined motion and order which shall be used by all parties, including private attorneys, the State Attorney, and the Public Defender, to request transportation of any prisoner.
- 3. The motion and order shall be delivered to the appropriate court for review and signature no later than:
- (a) For all inmates in the Hernando County Jail, two business days or forty-eight hours, whichever is longer, prior to any proceeding requiring the presence of the inmate.
- (b) For all inmates located in the other counties of the Fifth Judicial Circuit (i.e., Citrus, Lake, Marion, or Sumter), three business days or seventy-two hours, whichever is longer, prior to any proceeding requiring the presence of the inmate.
- (c) For all inmates located within the State of Florida, but outside the boundaries of the Fifth Circuit, seven business days prior to any proceeding requiring the presence of the inmate.
- 4. Requests for transportation of inmates located outside the State of Florida shall be made at least 14 days before any proceeding requiring the presence of the inmate, except as allowed by the trail court on a case by case basis.

5. These time frames shall be complied with by all counsel of record; however, in the event of emergency or exceptional circumstances, the presiding judge may on his own motion request transportation of a prisoner outside these parameters.
