ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. A2005-28-A

AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REQUIRING UNIFORMITY OF
TRANSFERENCE OF DRUG COURT CASES WITHIN THE FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

WHEREAS, there are established Drug Court Programs in various counties of this Fifth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for uniformity of acceptance of transferring Drug Court cases from county to county within the circuit; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of such uniform transference of cases will ensure fair and equitable treatment; It is therefore:


ORDERED

1. Any Drug Court participant who has met the standard of acceptance within any Drug Court Program in the Fifth Judicial Circuit shall be accepted for transference to another Drug Court Program within the Fifth Judicial Circuit.

2. The Drug Court participant, following the transfer, must thereafter meet the compliance standards as set forth by the Drug Court Program in the county of acceptance.
