
**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING FLORIDA STATUTE 905.01  
“TERM OF THE GRAND JURY”**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statute 905.01, as amended, requires the Chief Judge of the circuit to regularly order the convening of the grand jury for a term of six (6) months; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(5), the Chief Judge may designate a judge as “administrative judge”; it is

**THEREFORE**, Ordered that the Administrative Judges for their respective counties shall ensure compliance with the requirements of Florida Statute 905.01, as amended.
