DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INJUNCTION HEARING DOCKET

The undersigned having considered the need for flexibility in the scheduling of injunction hearings in Citrus County, having reviewed the requirements of Fla.Stat. 741.30(5)(a)(3)(c), and finding that the Court has the right to determine its own docket in compliance with the Statute; and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is thereupon

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Circuit Court Judge assigned to the domestic violence injunction hearing docket in Citrus County shall have authority under Fla.Stat. 741.30(5)(a)(3)(c), and for good cause shown, to set domestic violence injunction hearing dates accordingly.
2. It shall be the responsibility of the Clerk of Court's office to schedule said hearings as ordered by the Circuit Court Judge assigned to the domestic violence injunction hearing docket. In an effort to assist the Clerk in performing the function of scheduling said hearings, the domestic violence Judge, or Judicial Assistant, shall keep the Clerk's office advised of the Judge's calendar sufficiently in advance of the scheduling.
3. This Order shall be effective immediately.
