WITH FELONY OR JUVENILE CASES


IT COMING to the attention of the undersigned in his capacity as Administrative Judge that civil traffic cases (traffic infractions) are occasionally sent by the County Court to the Felony Court or to Juvenile Court, and there being no sound legal authority for such transfer, and it being the duty of the undersigned in his capacity as Administrative Judge to handle the flow of cases so as to maximize judicial efficiency, and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is upon consideration

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. All civil traffic cases (civil traffic infractions) shall be heard in County Court unless a circuit judge of competent jurisdiction orders otherwise.
