## AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING WRITS OF BODILY ATTACHMENT, 48-HOUR HEARINGS

WHEREAS, there is now a Child Support Hearing Officer presiding in Lake County three (3) days a week; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the increased availability of the Child Support Hearing Officer to hear more cases and conduct more hearings;

As Administrative Judge of Lake County and in accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(2), it is now therefore:

## **ORDERED:** That

Child Support Hearing Officer, JONI EMLING, shall conduct all Writ of Bodily Attachment 48-hour hearings on any Title IV-D child support writs of attachment in the following manner:

- 1. <u>Any inmate booked into the Lake County Jail between 12 PM (noon)</u> on Saturday through 11:59 PM on Thursday pursuant to a Title IV-D child support writ of attachment will be automatically referred to the Child Support Hearing Officer for disposition.
- Any inmate booked into the Lake County Jail between 12 AM (midnight) on Friday through 11:59 AM on Saturday pursuant to a Title IV-D child support writ of attachment will be automatically referred to the Weekend Duty Judge for disposition.
- 3. In any instance in which the Child Support Hearing Officer is unavailable to hear a Title IV-D child support writ of attachment, the Child Support Hearing Office will notify the Lake County Jail's booking office and other appropriate parties that the writ of attachment needs to be referred to the appropriate judge for disposition.
