IN RE: EXTENSION OF TIME TO PAY FINES ON NONCRIMINAL INFRACTIONS

WHEREAS Florida Statutes 318.14(4) requires that civil penalties and delinquent fees imposed under chapter 318, Florida Statutes must be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of receiving the citation; and

WHEREAS in certain noncriminal traffic infractions the statutory fine is in excess of \$100; and

WHEREAS requests for extension of time are submitted frequently by persons unable to pay the civil penalty within thirty (30) days;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to expedite the disposition of noncriminal traffic infractions, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:

The Deputy Clerks of the Misdemeanor and Traffic Division are authorized to grant extensions upon Defendant's written request for extension of time to pay noncriminal infraction civil penalties and delinquent fees as follows:

Fine Amount,
Including Costs

Extension Allowed

\$100 - \$200

30 days

\$201 and above

60 days

No extension of time will be allowed for any fine and costs amount under \$100.
