IN RE: DISMISSAL OF CHARGE FOR
FIRST VIOLATION OF BICYCLE
HELMET LAW

WHEREAS Florida Statute 316.2065(3)(e) provides that the court shall dismiss the charge against a bicycle rider or passenger for a first violation of F.S. 316.2065(3)(d) upon proof of purchase of a bicycle helmet that complies with said subsection;

NOW THEREFORE, in order to expedite the disposition of said civil infractions, it is hereby


ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:

The Deputy Clerks of the Traffic and Misdemeanor Division are authorized to dismiss said civil infractions upon Defendant providing proof of purchase of a bicycle helmet that complies with F.S. 316.2065(3)(d), provided the civil infraction is the Defendant's first violation.
