



**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER FOR COSTS OF SUPERVISION ON
CONCURRENT SENTENCES IN FELONY AND MISDEMEANOR CASES**

This order establishes the policy that the costs of supervision are to be split equally between the Office of the Florida Department of Corrections Probation and the Salvation Army Probation Services when a defendant has concurrent sentences of probation in both felony and misdemeanor cases while such sentences are being served at the same time.
