ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER M-2002-22

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER PERMITTING THE RELEASE OF
FLORIDA CRIME INFORMATION CENTER RECORDS
TO THE SALVATION ARMY PROBATION OFFICE

WHEREAS, in Marion County persons sentenced to a period of probation on misdemeanor charges are supervised by the Salvation Army Probation Department; and

WHEREAS, to determine probationers eligibility for rehabilitative programs and to assess potential security risks probationers may pose to probation counselors, the Salvation Army Probation Department needs access to criminal history information related to persons placed under their supervision; and


WHEREAS, the State Attorney's Office, for the Fifth Judicial Circuit, has agreed to provide criminal history information from the Florida Crime Information Center to the Salvation Army Probation Department; it is therefore

ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Salvation Army Probation Department may request and receive criminal history information from the Florida Crime Information Center provided by the State Attorney's Office of the Fifth Judicial Circuit related to persons placed under their supervision.

2. This Order shall become effective immediately.
