Therefore it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. With his approval and consent, the Honorable Robert E. Landt, Marion County Judge, is hereby recused from presiding in any case which may be assigned

to him wherein attorney FREDERICK E. LANDT, III, or THE LAW FIRM OF LANDT, WIECHENS, LAPEER AND AYRES appears as counsel of record and/or is a named party.

2. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to reassign such cases at random. (i.e. misdemeanor cases shall be randomly assigned to the County Judges presently on the misdemeanor docket, other case types shall be assigned to the docket of the judge(s) who is/are assigned to that case type).

- 3. Thereafter, the Clerk of the Court shall reassign a similar case type from the docket of the Judge who is receiving the reassigned case to the docket of the Honorable Robert E. Landt, in an equal assignment.
- 4. The provisions of this Order shall remain in effect until further ordered by the Undersigned.
