**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RESCINDING AND VACATING
DESIGNATED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**

WHEREAS, the undersigned Administrative Judge for Sumter County in the Fifth Judicial Circuit has entered numerous administrative orders throughout the years; and

WHEREAS, some of these orders are now outdated, or no longer necessary, and have not been purged, or rescinded by other orders, or have not been removed from the file of active administrative orders; and

WHEREAS, many administrative orders were entered for the limited purpose of establishing initial procedural policies, and it is not the intent to the undersigned to eliminate, or vacate any procedural policies which may have been established by administrative order, but rather to simply eliminate unneeded orders for established policy; it is therefore
