ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RESCINDING AND VACATING
DESIGNATED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS: L-2017-01, L-2017-31-A, L-2017-33,
L-2018-16, L-2018-45, and L-2018-50

WHEREAS, the undersigned Administrative Judge for Lake County in the Fifth Judicial Circuit has entered numerous administrative orders throughout the years; and

WHEREAS, some of these orders are now outdated, or no longer necessary, and have not been purged, or rescinded by other orders, or have not been removed from the file of active administrative orders; and


It is **THEREFORE ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED**
