Administrative Order: A-2014-12-A

**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING BAIL SCHEDULE, AND
AMENDING AND SUPERSEDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER A-2014-12**

WHEREAS persons arrested and charged with crimes or violations of municipal or county ordinances have a right to be released from jail custody on reasonable bail, if the offense is bailable and there are no circumstances adverse to release on bail; and,

WHEREAS there is a need for uniformity throughout the Fifth Judicial Circuit when establishing the amount of bail required for the same charge regardless of the county in which the offense occurs, the arrest is made, or the warrant is issued; and

WHEREAS the bail schedule is intended as a reference to assist law enforcement to establish a bond amount in connection with arrest,

In consideration thereof and in accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is

ORDERED

1. The attached Bail Schedule shall continue to be the official Bail Schedule for the Fifth Judicial Circuit.
2. Administrative Order A-2014-12 is hereby superseded and amended.
3. The attached Bail Schedule was first approved by A-2014-12 on May 16, 2014, and remains unchanged.
