OTHER TRIAL COURT PROCEEDINGS VIA VIDEO CONFERENCE AND TELEPHONE



THE FOLLOWING PROCEEDINGS ARE AMENABLE TO BEING CONDUCTED REMOTELY AS ORDERED BY THE FLORIDA SUPREME COURT:

Alternative dispute resolution proceedings; Status, case management, and pretrial conferences in all case types; Non-evidentiary and evidentiary motion hearings in all case types; Pleas in absentia in county court misdemeanor cases; Hearings in juvenile delinquency cases; Hearings in noncriminal traffic infraction cases; Hearings in involuntary commitment of sexually violent predator cases; Problem-solving court staffings, hearings, and wellness checks; and Non-jury trials in all case types, except for:

1. Criminal cases unless the parties in such case agree to the remote conduct of a non-jury trial; or
2. Termination of parental rights or juvenile delinquency cases, unless the chief judge or the presiding judge in the case determines that the non-jury trial should proceed remotely.
