ALL CIRCUIT AND COUNTY COURTS SHALL CONTINUE TO PERFORM ESSENTIAL COURT PROCEEDINGS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

First appearance; Criminal arraignments; Hearings on motions to set or modify monetary bail for individuals who are in custody; Juvenile dependency shelter hearings; Juvenile delinquency detention hearings; Hearings on petitions for injunctions relating to safety of an individual; Hearings on petitions for risk protection orders; Hearings on petitions for the appointment of an emergency temporary guardian; Hearings to determine whether an individual should be involuntarily committed under the Baker Act or the Marchman Act; And hearings on petitions for extraordinary writs as necessary to protect the constitutional rights.

Other trial court proceedings will be held via video conference and telephone.
