RE: SPECIALTY COURT

Screening for Specialty Court requires a written motion and approval of the assigned Judge. The screening does not guarantee admission to Specialty Court.

Until such time, the Defendant has pled in/been accepted into Specialty Court the <u>Defendant</u> is responsible for all Court hearing/dates before the assigned criminal Judge as well as the Specialty Court Judge. Upon acceptance into Specialty Court the clerk, upon order, shall strike further Court hearings before the criminal assigned Judge. If the Defendant is not accepted into Specialty Court, the Defendant shall be returned to the regular criminal docket and assigned Judge.

Note: Cases shall not be placed on the Specialty Court Docket within 1 week of approval of screening. This results in insufficient time for the parties to be informed about their cases.

The State shall also provide the Court with a memorandum as to sentencing range points as well as victims opinions/approval of Defendant's participation in Specialty Court.
