**IN RE: SPECIAL APPOINTMENT TO THE FIFTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
CERTIFIED CIVIL PROCESS SERVER REVIEW BOARD**

(amended only to replace Eugene Harper with Quinn Sampson)

WHEREAS, in keeping with the public trust and legal importance of proper service of process, Administrative Order A-2008-21-B was entered to ensure proficiency and professionalism in the service of civil process; and

WHEREAS, it has been established by Administrative Order A-2008-21-B that a special need exists in the Fifth Circuit to have a Certified Civil Process Server Review Board to monitor the certification, conduct and professionalism of persons certified pursuant to said Administrative Order and Section 48.25, et seq., Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the terms for the Members of the Board as established and appointed by Administrative Order A-2016-19 has expired; and

WHEREAS, the Certified Civil Process Server Review Board shall be composed of one (1) Certified Civil Process Server, one (1) licensed attorney who is a member of the Florida Bar, one (1) representative of a Clerk of Court within this Circuit who is familiar with the service of process, one (1) representative of the law enforcement community in this Circuit who is familiar with the service of process and one (1) additional individual to be determined by the Undersigned, Chief Judge;


IT IS THEREFORE,

ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The following individuals are appointed as members of the Certified Civil Process Server Review Board:
 - a. Joseph W. Groeneveld, as a Certified Civil Process Server;

- b. Gary James Cooney, Esquire, as a licensed attorney who is a member of the Florida Bar;
 - c. Debbie Kennedy, as a representative of a Clerk of Court within the Circuit who is familiar with the service of process;
 - d. Penni S. Norris on an interim basis until such time as Chuck Nall, State Attorney Investigator in and for the Fifth Judicial Circuit, is able to perform his duties on the Review Board;
 - e. Corporal Quinn Sampson of the Marion County Sheriff Office, as a representative of Law Enforcement shall be appointed by amendment.
- 2. The Board shall have all powers, duties, and obligations as set forth in Administrative Order A-2008-21-B.
 - 3. This Special Appointment is effective as of July 23, 2020, and each appointee, except an interim appointee, shall serve a three (3) year term.
