- Petition must be signed and notarized

- Service by Publication or Posting Note: you must attempt personal service at the Respondent's last known address before filing an affidavit of diligent search-- Affidavit of Diligent Search Form 12.913 (c) NOTE: This affidavit must be filled out completely with supporting documentation attached to the affidavit.
- **By Publication:** Must publish once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a publication in the county of the Court [See Florida Statute 49.10 (1)(a)].
- **By Posting:** if the Petitioner is found indigent by the Clerk of Court

**Copy of driver's license or voter's registration card** - Driver's License/Voter Registration <u>MUST</u> be issued at least 6 months <u>PRIOR</u> to the date of filing, in the alternative, you may complete an Affidavit of Corroborating Witness <u>Form 12.902 (i)</u> if your license was recently renewed/issued.
