- **By Publication:** Must publish once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a publication in the county of the Court [See Florida Statute 49.10 (1)(a)]. PETITIONER RESPONSIBLE FOR PUBLISHING IN NEWSPAPER
- By Posting: if the Petitioner is found indigent by the Clerk of Court CLERK WILL POST FOR PETITIONER

Copy of Driver's License or Voter's Registration Card - Driver's License/Voter Registration <u>MUST</u> be issued at least 6 months <u>PRIOR</u> to the date of filing, in the alternative, you may complete an Affidavit of Corroborating Witness <u>Form 12.902 (i)</u> if your license was recently renewed/issued.
