- **Petition for Temporary Custody by Extended Family** <u>Form 12.970 (a) or (b)</u> Please read all directions and <u>complete the petition in its entirety</u>. Please pay particular attention to the following:
 - Florida must have been the home state of the child(ren) named in the Petition at least 6 months prior to the date of filing
 - List of all child(ren) and birth dates
 - Petitioner(s) must be related to the minor child(ren) within the 3rd degree by blood or marriage to a parent or the stepparent of the minor child(ren)
 - Petition must be signed and notarized
 - List all parents in Petition
- Coversheet for Family Court Cases <u>Form 12.928</u>
- Disclosure from Nonlawyer <u>Form 12.900 (a)</u>
- Designation of Current Mailing and Email Address Form (per A.O. A-2022-47)
- Notice of Social Security Number <u>Form 12.902 (j)</u>
- Certified Copy of ALL Minor Child(ren)'s Birth Certificate(s)
- **UCCJEA Affidavit** Form 12.902 (d) MUST include child(ren)'s residence for last 5 years (or since birth if under age 5)
 - Family Law Financial Affidavit (choose only one based on annual income)
 - Short form 12.902 (b) annual income under \$50,000
 - Long form 12.902 (c) annual income **over** \$50,000

Service of Process on Responding Party

Personal Service - Personal service is required if the party's whereabouts are known.

• Summons: Personal Service on an Individual - Form 12.910(a)

Alternatively, the Respondent may file an Answer to Petition and Waiver of Service of Process. (<u>FORM</u> <u>12.903(a) OR 12.903(b) OR 12.903(c)(2)</u>) Forms are available at <u>www.circuit5.org</u>

<u>Service by Publication or Posting</u> - You <u>must</u> attempt personal service at the Respondent's last known address before filing an affidavit of diligent search.

• Affidavit of Diligent Search - Form 12.913 (b)

NOTE: This affidavit must be filled out completely with supporting documentation attached to the affidavit.

- **By Publication:** Must publish once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in a publication in the county of the Court [See Florida Statute 49.10 (1)(a)]. PETITIONER RESPONSIBLE FOR PUBLISHING IN NEWSPAPER
- **By Posting:** If the Petitioner is found indigent by the Clerk of Court CLERK WILL POST FOR PETITIONER

- Concurrent *Form 12.970 (d)*
- Notice of Related Cases Form 12.900 (h)
- **Motion for Default and Default** *Forms 12.922 (a and b)* Filed when more than twenty (20) days from service has passed and Responding party has NOT filed an Answer
