ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER L-2023-27

RE: GOVERNING MANDATORY FILING OF AFFIDAVIT OF HEIRS IN ESTATE ADMINISTRATIONS IN LAKE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, charges the chief judge with the authority to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice in the courts over which he or she is chief judge; and,

WHEREAS, the Florida Supreme Court, pursuant to Rule 2.215(5) of the Florida Rules of General Practice & Judicial Administration permits the Chief Judge to designate a judge in any court or court division as an Administrative Judge; and,

WHEREAS, the undersigned, the Honorable James R. Baxley, has been designated by the Chief Judge as Administrative Judge for Lake County, pursuant to Rule 2.215(b)(5), Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration; and,

WHEREAS the fair, efficient, and proper administration of matters of probate is in the interest of the public and the courts of Lake County; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the requirement of filing a standardized Affidavit of Heirs is to alert attorneys and self-represented litigants of the need to file the Affidavit of Heirs in estate cases and to ensure complete information is provided to the court concerning the potential heirs in each estate so that estate cases can be efficiently probated.

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and appropriate for the

prompt, effective, and efficient administration of justice within the Courts of Lake County, Florida; with the advice and consent of the Chief Judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit and all Lake County Judges who handle probate cases;

It is **THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. All litigants must file the attached Affidavit of Heirs in every probate case filed within Lake County. This requirement may be waived in an appropriate case by petition or motion to the court.
- 2. Litigants must fill-in all required sections of the Affidavit. The Affidavit must be notarized. Any filing subject to this Administrative Order which fails to include the Affidavit of Heirs may be rejected and thus have to be refiled in compliance with this requirement.
