WHEREAS, the Florida Supreme Court has entered SC2023-0916 IN RE: AMENDMENTS TO FLORIDA SUPREME COURT APPROVED FAMILY LAW FORM 12.915 and SC2023-0919 IN RE: AMENDMENTS TO FLORIDA SUPREME COURT APPROVED FAMILY LAW FORMS 12.980(a), 12.980(f), 12.980(n), 12.980(q), AND 12.980(t) which have the effect of making Administrative Orders A-2022-47 and A-2022-55 outdated and no longer necessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The following administrative orders of the Fifth Judicial Circuit are hereby rescinded, vacated, or superseded:
