- **Petition for Adoption of Adult by Stepparent** <u>Form 12.981(c)(1)</u> Please read all directions and <u>complete the petition **entirely**</u>.
 - Petitioner or the adoptee MUST be a resident of Marion County
 - Petition must be signed and notarized by petitioner(s)
- Designation of Current Mailing and E-Mail Address <u>Form 12.915</u>
- Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases <u>Form 12.928</u>
- Notice of Related Cases Form 12.900 (h)
- Stepparent Adoption: Consent of Adoptee Form 12.981(a)(2)
 - Consent must be witnessed by two persons and notarized by a third person who is a notary §63.082 (4)(d), Fla.Stat.
- **Stepparent Adoption: Consent of Adult Adoptee's Spouse** <u>Form 12.981(c)(2)</u> Required if the adult adoptee is married.
 - Consent must be witnessed by two persons and notarized by a third person who is a notary §63.082 (4)(d), Fla.Stat.

Service of Process on Biological Parents

The biological parents must either receive written Notice of the Final Hearing on Adoption or Proof of Service of Process showing Notice has been served (Ref: Florida Statute 63.062 (8)(b))
