**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER APPOINTING CHAIRS

**WHEREAS**, in order to provide effective coordination of professionalism programs and activities throughout the Fifth Judicial Circuit and in accordance with the Florida Supreme Court's Administrative Order entitled In Re: Commission on Professionalism, dated June 11, 1998, mandating the establishment of a local Professionalism Committee in each judicial circuit; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of promoting professionalism, a Professionalism Committee allows the bench and the Bar to coordinate professional activities for lawyers and judges in furtherance of and in an effort to maintain the highest standards of professionalism in the Circuit, this Fifth Judicial Circuit has established the Fifth Judicial Circuit Professionalism Committee, Educational Division and the Fifth Judicial Circuit Professionalism Committee, Professionalism Practice Division; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 6, 2013, the Florida Supreme Court entered Administrative Order No.:SC2023-0884 In Re: Code For Resolving Professionalism Referrals and Amendments to Rule Regulating The Florida Bar 6-10.3; and

**WHEREAS**, said Order mandates the formation of a single, circuit wide, Local Professionalism Panel to receive, screen and act upon any and all referrals of claimed unprofessional conduct and to resolve those referrals informally, if possible, or refer to The Florida Bar if necessary;


