- Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases <u>Form 12.928</u>
- Notice of Related Cases Form 12.900(h)
- Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (UCCJEA) Affidavit Form 12.902(d)
- Affidavit of Military Service Form 12.912(b) One for each parent.
- Waiver of Service of Process and Consent for Temporary Custody by Extended Family

  Form 12.970(c) When the legal parent(s) are in agreement with the Petition. One for each parent is required. If parent(s) are not in agreement, Service of Process on the parent(s) is required. Refer to instructions below.

- \*\*<u>MUST</u> attempt Personal Service at respondent's last known address <u>BEFORE</u> proceeding with this type of service\*\* This is a complicated area of the law and you may want to consult with an attorney before using constructive service.
  - Affidavit of Diligent Search and Inquiry <u>Form 12.913 (b)</u> Attach supporting documentation.
  - Notice of Action Form 12.913(a)(1) Read instructions thoroughly.
