

SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

- **Petition for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage** - Form 12.901(a) Read all directions and complete the petition entirely.
- **Copy of Florida Driver's License or Florida Identification Card.** Must be issued at least 6 months prior to the date of filing. Alternatively, if your Florida Driver's License or Florida Identification Card does not meet the 6 month criteria, you must file the following:
 - **Affidavit of Corroborating Witness** - Form 12.902(i) **AND**
 - **Affidavit of Residency** (located on www.circuit5.org, under Self-Help, Lake County)
- **Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases** - Form 12.928
- **Notice of Related Cases** - Form 12.900(h)
- **Designation of Current Mailing and E-Mail Address** – Form 12.915 - Each party must file.
- **Notice of Social Security Number** - Form 12.902(j) – Each party must file.
- **Family Law Financial Affidavit** – Each party **must file**
 - Short Form - Form 12.902(b) If gross individual annual income is under \$50,000
 - Long Form - Form 12.902(c) If gross individual annual income is above \$50,000
- **Marital Settlement Agreement for Simplified Dissolution of Marriage** - Form 12.902(f)(3) **BOTH** parties must sign.

OR

If **both** parties agree to waive filing financials, both parties may **jointly** complete the following form:

- **Notice of Joint Verified Waiver of Filing Financial Affidavits** - Form 12.902 (k) (all criteria must be met)
