

STEPPARENT ADOPTION (MINOR CHILD(REN))

If you have questions or concerns about these forms, instructions, commentary, the use of the forms, or your legal rights, it is strongly recommended that you talk to an attorney. Because the law does change, the forms and information about them may have become outdated. You should be aware that changes may have taken place in the law or court rules that would affect the accuracy of the forms or instructions.

- **Joint Petition for Adoption by Stepparent** - Form 12.981(b)(1) Please read all directions and complete the petition *entirely*.
- **Designation of Current Mailing and E-Mail Address** - Form 12.915
- **Cover Sheet for Family Court Cases** - Form 12.928
- **Notice of Related Cases** - Form 12.900(h)
- **Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (UCCJEA) Affidavit** - Form 12.902(d)
- **Indian Child Welfare Act Affidavit** - Form 12.981(a)(5)
- **Stepparent Adoption: Consent of Adoptee** - Form 12.981(a)(2) – Must be completed if the adoptee is over 12 years old.
- **Stepparent Adoption: Consent and Waiver by Parent** - Form 12.981(a)(1) – Filed by natural parent whose parental rights are being terminated. If there is no agreement refer to Service of Process below.
- **Motion for Search of the Putative Father Registry** - Form 12.981(a)(6) Pursuant to Florida Statute 63.054(7)(a) a search of the Putative Father Registry shall be done in **ALL** adoption cases, regardless of joint petitioner being the natural father. After the Court has signed the order granting the motion, a **certified** copy from the Clerk's Office must be obtained and mailed to Florida Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics along with the application and fee to perform the search. - **Stepparent Adoption: Affidavit of Nonpaternity** Form 12.981(a)(3) – Use of this form is **required only** when a stepfather is adopting his wife's minor child, **and** the mother and natural father were never married and paternity has **not** been established by a valid acknowledgement or court proceeding.
- **Certified Copy of Adoptee(s) Birth Certificate(s)**

SERVICE OF PROCESS IS REQUIRED ON THE NATURAL PARENT UNLESS A CONSENT AND WAIVER BY PARENT (FORM 12.981(a)(1)) IS SIGNED BY LEGAL PARENT WHOSE PARENTAL RIGHTS ARE BEING TERMINATED.

Personal Service

- **Summons: Personal Service on an Individual - Form 12.910(a)**
- **Process Service Memorandum - Form 12.910(b)**

Constructive Service

****MUST attempt Personal Service at respondent's last known address BEFORE proceeding with this type of service****

This is a complicated area of the law and you may want to consult with an attorney before using constructive service.

- **Affidavit of Diligent Search - Form 12.913(c)** – Attach all supporting documentation.
- **Notice of Action for Termination of Parental Rights and Stepparent Adoption - Form 12.913(a)(3)** – Read instructions thoroughly. Publication is required.

- **Additional Forms:**

- **Motion for Default and Default - Forms 12.922 (a and b)** Filed when more than twenty (20) days from service has passed and Responding party has NOT filed an Answer.
- **Notice for Trial - Form 12.924**
