**IN RE: CASE ASSIGNMENTS OF ANY CASE WHEREIN ANY ATTORNEY FROM
THE HUNT LAW FIRM, P.A., IS AN ATTORNEY OF RECORD**

THIS CAUSE came before the Administrative Judge, *sua sponte*, regarding the future reassignment of any and all cases assigned to the Honorable George Singeltary, Circuit Judge, wherein counsel for any party is associated with The Hunt Law Firm, P.A. It has been brought to the attention of the undersigned that an actual or perceived conflict of interest may arise in the assignment of cases referenced above. To maintain judicial integrity, a recusal of, and reassignment from, the Honorable George Singeltary is appropriate in any case wherein an attorney from The Hunt Law Firm, P.A., is listed as counsel of record and/or where The Hunt Law Firm, P.A., is listed as a party. Thus, it is **ORDERED**:

1. With his approval and consent, the Honorable George Singeltary, Circuit Judge, is hereby recused from presiding over any case which may be assigned to him in the future where The Hunt Law Firm, P.A., is the attorney of record, and/or is listed as a party to the lawsuit.
2. County Court Judges, the Honorable Edward Spaight and the Honorable Amber Thomas, are hereby assigned as Circuit Court Judges of the Fifth Judicial Circuit on the cases for which they are assigned pursuant to this Order of Assignment until completion of the case.
3. The Clerk of Court is hereby directed to reassign such cases in an equal rotation among the following judges: the Honorable Kyle Lambert, the Honorable Edward Spaight, and the Honorable Amber Thomas.
4. The provisions of this Order shall remain in effect until further order of the undersigned.
