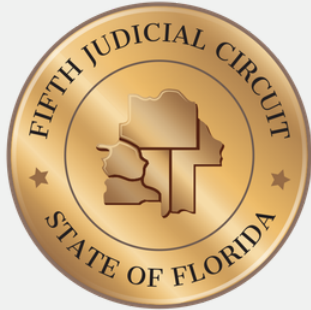


JUDICIAL APPOINTMENT

George L. Singeltary II

Circuit Judge, Citrus County

Governor Ron DeSantis appointed George L. Singeltary II to the Circuit Court for Citrus County in 2026.



Born and raised in Leesburg, Florida, he graduated from Leesburg High School in 2001 before earning his bachelor's degree from Washington and Lee University in 2005, and his Juris Doctor from Florida Coastal School of Law in 2009.

After law school, he worked in the private sector and later practiced criminal law. His legal career includes experience in four of the five counties within the Fifth Judicial Circuit, including Lake, Marion, Sumter, and Citrus.

In 2022, he was appointed as a General Magistrate in Lake County, where he presided over domestic relations matters and completed numerous family law bench trials.

Judge George L. Singeltary II began his service on the bench on June 22, 2026.
