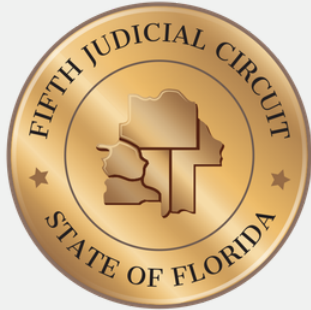


JUDICIAL APPOINTMENT

Governor Ron DeSantis appointed Shelby D. Senn to the County Court for Sumter County in 2026.



As a Lake County native, she graduated from Leesburg High School before earning her Bachelor of Science from Florida State University in 2014 and her Juris Doctor from Barry University School of Law in 2017.

She served as an Assistant State Attorney in the Fifth Judicial Circuit in Sumter County since 2017 handling cases ranging from Misdemeanors, Juvenile cases, Problem-Solving Court and Felonies. Most recently, she handled cases in the Special Victims Unit where she prosecuted cases involving crimes against children and worked with victims of sex crimes.
